A few polite reminders:

- The amount of unclaimed uniform that was left over at the end of last year was frightening! Please ensure your child/children's name is clearly labelled in their school uniform.
- Please be 'Nut Aware' and be mindful when packing lunch boxes as there are a number of children in our school family who have severe allergies.
- Please continue to <u>park in the village car park</u> and not on Arrowcroft Road (20mph) as we must <u>keep</u> <u>our children safe</u>. Ensure you keep within the speed limit and that you keep driveways free so that residents can leave and enter their properties.
- <u>A new Home/School Agreement</u> is attached in School Spider and we would appreciate you spending the time to read it through and agree to it as a family.
- Please continue to refresh/update the School Spider App in your App Store so that it runs as efficiently as possible.













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- KS2 meals will cost <u>£2.68</u> and can be ordered as usual via School Spider before 8am each day. We are
 fully aware that the current financial climate has impacted families. If you have any concerns
 regarding payments, please pop in or call to speak to me in confidence.
- Absence requests will be authorised only if the circumstances are deemed exceptional.
- The <u>safety</u> of our children is of the utmost importance please ensure you phone, email or send a School Spider message to <u>Mrs. Lloyd or Mrs. Taylor</u> in the office to <u>report an absence</u> and/or changes to <u>pick up arrangements</u>.
