A polite reminder from Mrs. Cawley.

At Guilden Sutton, reading for pleasure is our ultimate goal and listening to your child read at home contributes to this hugely. We recognise that as our readers progress through Key Stage 2, they read with much more independence and may feel they no longer need to read to an adult. However, for our children to be fluent and enthusiastic readers who read widely, it is vital that they are listened to and that this is recorded in reading records.

To ensure the aims in our Home School Agreement can be fulfilled, please ensure that:

- reading records and reading books are in school every day
- children read to an adult at least twice a week
- a comment is written in reading records by an adult following each read.

Please note, children will still be encouraged to record in their own reading record, we just ask for these to be supplemented by the additional comments written by an adult.

As a school, we will continue to make reading our utmost priority and we will use your child's reading record to communicate the reading that your child is doing in school.
