Payments not working

- Ensure you have strong WiFi/4G/5G signal
- Ensure you have the most up to date version of the app
- Ensure your phone operating system is up to date

No record of payments

All orders can be found in the menu > parent profile > previous orders. Parents also receive email receipts with their orders.

Payment Details

We do not currently store card details, but this is something we are looking into. We are also looking to introduce Apple and Google Pay in the near future.

Messages

We do not have the option to delete messages. Our research showed that parents preferred to have a record of all messages received. If a parent reads a message, the notification will no longer show.

Logging In

The app does keep parents logged in. For example, I have been logged in since April 2021. The only times a parent would need to log back in is if they had logged out, if the school had updated PR or priority settings in the MIS, or if the parent had deleted and reinstalled the app.



Over the past few years, Mrs. Williams has been working tirelessly to achieve the Artsmark Award, accredited by Arts Council England.
