Well done to the <u>Year 6 girls</u> for coming second in the <u>touch rugby competition</u>. Mr. Carlile was over the moon!















The Department of Education White Paper - Opportunity for all: strong schools with great teachers for your child, has stated that, 'By September 2023 at the latest, all state-funded, mainstream schools will be expected to provide a compulsory school week of at least 32.5 hours.'

To ensure this is securely in place for <u>September 2023</u>, with any bumps in the road ironed out, we will be implementing this **change from <u>January 2023</u>**.

- To allow for a <u>smoother transition</u>, so that children have maximum teaching and learning time, I will open the door at 8:45am.

- The school day finishes for KS1 at 3:20pm.
- The school day finishes for KS2 at 3:20pm (time stays the same).
- The school day finishes for Reception (EYFS) at 3:10pm (time stays the same).

I am aware that pick up is from two different entrances and that some families have children in both KS1 and KS2 but let us see how things go and we can then make changes if/where necessary!

Key Priority 3:


