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#### School Priorities for 2022 – 2023:

To trial, purchase and implement a new computing scheme of work. Mr Hilsden (Y5 teacher and Computing lead) has purchased KAPOW which is our new scheme of work. There is clear progression from Reception – Year 6 where the children are taught statutory key knowledge and skills. New equipment has also been purchased and we have strong links with Bishops High School and Digital Wizards who lead enrichment workshops. Maintain the exceptional standards of behaviour and attitudes to learning throughout the whole school. Our children continue to be kind, courteous and compassionate. They have a 'thirst' for knowledge and learning something new and it is a pleasure to feel the 'buzz' of hard work and enthusiasm when I walk around school. To continue to improve the school building, especially the roof and the entrance. • The first phase of the new school roof is completed and we are hoping the second phase will continue in the Summer Term. We are also in discussions about updating our school entrance. To ensure the new SLT staffing structure is rigorous and robust. Mr. Dominic May (Y6 teacher and maths lead) is now part of the SLT structure and works extremely closely with myself and Mrs. Caroline Cawley (Assistant Headteacher) to ensure the school development points and priorities are rigorous and robust, ensuring all Ofsted grade descriptors are constantly evaluated and next steps are agreed. To further develop and resource the EYFS Learning Environment. • We have utilised some grant funding to further enhance the EYFS provision.
