A message from Public Health England:

As we move towards winter, respiratory illnesses including COVID-19 and flu can become a concern in childcare and education settings. You may also have heard about a new COVID-19 variant, BA.2.86, that was identified in England during August 2023. The UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) is closely monitoring the activity of this variant, in addition to all respiratory illnesses.

What to do if a child tests positive for COVID-19?

Most people can no longer access free testing for COVID-19. It is not recommended that children and young people are tested for COVID-19 unless directed by a health professional.

For children and young people aged 18 and under who test positive for COVID-19, the advice is to try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for three days. This is because children and young people tend to be infectious to other people for less time than adults.
